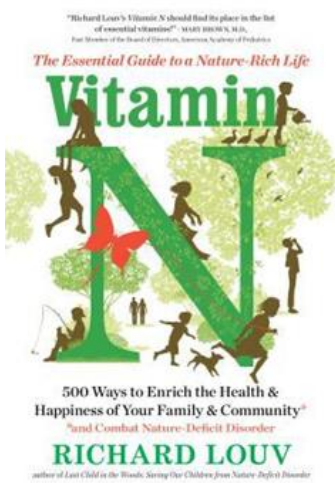

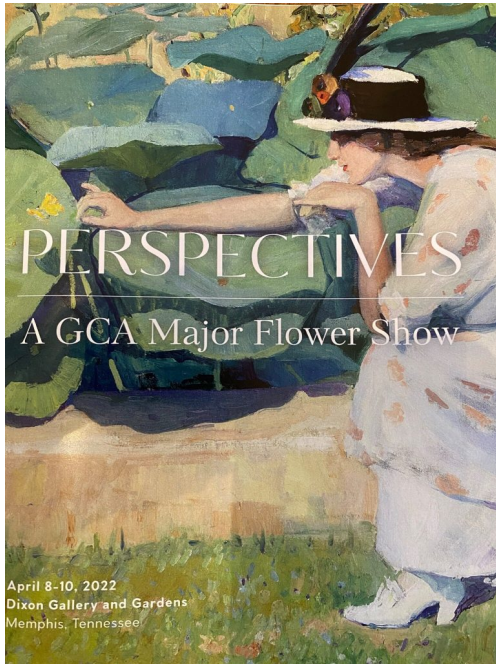
If you are interested in changing your membership category, you must send to me in writing by **May 1**. Please refer to Pages 65-68 in your yearbook.
