Linda reported: We renewed our CD's in November for another 6 months at an annual rate of .35% Increase of \$25,000 to the Administrative CD Increase of \$10,000 to the Memorial CD Increase of \$45,000 to the Community CD Increase of \$8,000 to the Education Fund C.D. We reduced the Children's Garden CD by \$7500 We reduced the Sensory Garden CD by \$3,600 We increased the Zone Account CD by \$17,091
