Kate called on Linda Mallory for the Treasurer's report. Linda reported the following numbers as of 1/31/22:

Administrative: \$27,282.05 (+CD of \$55,818.21)
Community: \$48,970.87 (+CD of \$86,090.93)
Zone: \$5,516.82 (+CD of \$47,818.21)
Children's Garden: \$9,961.49 (+CD of \$38,727.31)
Sensory Garden: \$10, 566.72 (+CD of \$32,354.56)
Memorial Account: \$6,522.03 (+CD of \$21,300.00)
Education Account: \$7,923.78 (+CD of \$28,545.46)

## Linda reported:

We renewed our CD's in November for another 6 months at an annual rate of .35%

Increase of \$25,000 to the Administrative CD

Increase of \$10,000 to the Memorial CD

Increase of \$45,000 to the Community CD

Increase of \$8,000 to the Education Fund C.D.

We reduced the Children's Garden CD by \$7500

We reduced the Sensory Garden CD by \$3,600

We increased the Zone Account CD by \$17,091

As is our custom when a member dies, we sent a \$250 memorial to the MBG in memory of Norma Owen.

Anne Keesee reported on the LGC Auction, to be held March 31st at the Memphis Botanic Garden. All members need to turn in their auction items ASAP. Anne Keesee and Weetie Whittemore are concerned about including husbands at night because the lack of large items for live auction.
